Cherokee Nation Construction Resources (CNCR) is accepting bids from interested parties for the construction of waterlines, sanitary sewer lines with lift station, paving and storm sewer improvements for the new residential subdivision entitled "West Siloam Springs Estate" located in West Siloam Springs, Oklahoma. CNCR will be given the option to award to multiple vendors based upon previous assigned projects and time. The scope of work and specifications are included in this bid packet.

Interested parties are to provide a bid to furnish all labor, quality control, materials, supplies and supervision to complete the entire project. Interested bidders must follow all directions outlined in this packet including the utilization of mandatory bid response sheet to be considered fully responsive.

The lowest most responsive, responsible bid will be the determining factor in awarding this bid taking Indian Preference into consideration. The successful bidder will be issued an agreement and a purchase order incorporating the bid response.

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed, required form with all areas completed. Bidders are allowed to submit bids on individual schedules or all schedules. Bidders area responsible



for any and all costs associated with the preparation and submission of bids. To be considered, bids must be received by the specified date and time; any bid received after stipulated date and time will be returned unopened. No bidder may withdraw their bid within 30 days after proposal due date.
