Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation BID REQUEST

The Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation is seeking bids from interested parties for the completion of Labor and Materials Sub Contracting for **Drywall, hanging and finishing labor and materials** for Eleven (11) 3 Bedroom homes with attached garages located in Vinita, Oklahoma. **Two** of the units will be **Handicap Accessible**. This is a New Construction Housing Development Project and all work will be completed per the work write-up. **TO BE CONSIDERED A RESPONSIVE/RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, THE BID SHEET MUST BE FULLY COMPLETED. Bids are due no later than 5:00 P.M. October 10th, 2017.** Contractor must self-perform all labor required, no subcontracting of labor will be allowed.

The lowest most responsive, responsible bid will be the determining factor in awarding this bid based on the Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation Policy and Procedure. The successful bidder will be issued a purchase order incorporating the bid response. Bidder agrees to complete the HACN Development project in a timely manner in order not to hold up the entire project, Failure to comply and HACN reserves the right to award to the next lowest bidder anytime the need arises.

MANDATORY SUBMITTAL INFORMATION: Bid submittal requirements must be followed. Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed, required form with all areas completed. If forwarded by mail, the envelope containing the bid and all other required, completed documents must be received on or before due date listed and **must be clearly identified “Bid Enclosed” Attn: Delana Kimble**. Bids may be mailed to the Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation, Attn: Delana Kimble, P.O. Box 1007, Tahlequah, OK 74465. Bids may be hand delivered to Delana Kimble, 5000 S. Muskogee Ave., (Hopkins Building) Tahlequah, Oklahoma 74464 or e-mailed to delana.kimble@hacn.org **It is the bidder’s responsibility to ensure delivery of bids by October 10th, 2017 by 5:00 P.M. Any bids received after the designated date and time will be ineligible for award.**

Bid Acceptance: Bids will be accepted from Cherokee Tribal, Indian and Non-Indian bidders. Tribal and Indian preference will be given ONLY to bidders who provide current certification from the Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) located at the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma, P.O. Box 948, Tahlequah, Oklahoma, 74465, telephone number (918) 453-5000. Failure to submit the TERO certification with the bid, or within three (3) days of deadline may result in denial of Indian preference. This contract is subject to section 7 (b) of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act which requires in part that to

the greatest extent feasible, preference in the award of contracts and subcontracts shall be given to Indian Organizations and Indian Owned Economic Enterprises. Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation reserves the right to determine if a bid meets stated requirements, and to award a purchase order for the bid that is in the best interest of the Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation including but not limited to the total cost and capability of the bidder. Bidders are responsible for any and all costs associated with the preparation and submission of bids. To be considered, bids must be received by the specified date and time; any bid received after the stipulated date and time will be returned unopened. No bidder may withdraw their bid within 30 days after proposal due date.

Wage Rates #OK170005 is applicable to this project.

Bidder should visit the job site and acquaint themselves with the exact nature of work to be performed. To schedule a site, visit contact Construction Supervisor, **Jimmy Hullinger at 918-772-8075**. At the time of the bid opening each bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and familiarized themselves with any existing conditions. There will be no change orders to process based on mistaken quantity count, measurements or dimensions.

Indian Preference: Indian preference will be given only to bidders who provide proof of current certification from the Cherokee Nation Tribal Employments Office (TERO) located in Tahlequah, Oklahoma, telephone number (918) 453-5334. Proof of TERO certification (Copy of TERO Certificate (front & back) must accompany and be included in bid submittal.)

TERO requirements apply including fee of ½ of 1% of contract award. Successful bidder must complete TERO Labor Agreement and pay all applicable fees, including \$25 per day for every non-Indian employee working on this project in accordance with Legislative Act 01-14, contact TERO office @ 918-453-5334 with any questions.

Method of Award – Lowest Bid That Contains Lowest Most Responsive/Reasonable Offer from Qualified Bidder: After consideration of price and other factors, the purchase order will be awarded to the bidder whose bid is determined to be the lowest most responsive/reasonable offer and in the best interest of the HACN to accept in accordance with HACN Policy & Procedure. Award shall be made under unrestricted solicitations to the lowest, most responsive/reasonable bid from a qualified economic enterprise or organization within the maximum total budget price established for the specific project or activity being solicited. TERO Preference will be given only to bidders who provide proof of current TERO certification from the Cherokee Nation Tribal Employments Office (TERO). **Proof of TERO certification must accompany and be included in bid submittal.**

Method of Payment – Contractor will be paid **100%** of bid amount at the completion of each individual unit. All payments will be paid upon completion and acceptance of work and approved by the HACN Inspector and with all required paperwork submitted to the HACN.

Debarment, Suspension, Proposed Debarment, and Other Responsibility

Matters: The responding party certifies to the best of its knowledge and belief that the person, the firm, or any of its principals are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, or declared ineligible for the award of contracts by any Federal agency or Indian tribe. The bidder will also certify they have not, within a three-year period preceding this Request for Proposal, been convicted of or had a civil judgment rendered against them for: commission of fraud or a criminal offense in connection with obtaining, attempting to obtain, or performing a public (Federal, State, Local or Tribal) contract or subcontract; violation of Federal or State antitrust statutes relating to the submission of offers; or commissions of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsifications or destruction of records, making false statements, and are not presently indicted for, or otherwise criminally or civilly charged by a governmental entity with, commission of any of the offenses enumerated in this provision. The responding party certifies they have not, within a three-year period preceding this Request for Proposal/ Request for Bids, had one or more contracts terminated for default by a Federal, State, Local or Tribal agency. The responding party shall provide immediate written notice to the Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation if, at any time prior to contract award, the person learns its certification was erroneous when submitted or has become erroneous by reason of changed circumstances.

General Information: Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject all bids. Award of purchase order will be to the lowest most responsible responsive bidder and will be subject to availability of funds. Indian preference will be given to Contractors certified as an Indian-Owned firm by the Cherokee Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office (T.E.R.O.). **Proof of certification must accompany all bids.** No bidder may withdraw their bid within thirty (30) days after bid opening date.

A prospective contractor seeking to receive Indian Preference under this contract must be certified as an Indian-owned firm by the Cherokee Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) and submit proof of that certification with their bid.

Insurance Requirements – before performing contractual services on the behalf of or for the Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation, compliance with the following insurance requirements must be verified. Provide an original Certificate of Insurance naming the Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma as a certificate holder.

The certificate should contain the following information:

- 1) Type of insurance
- 2) Policy number
- 3) Effective date
- 4) Expiration date
- 5) Limits of Liability (this amount is usually stated in thousands)
- 6) Ten-day cancellation clause

Drug Free and Tobacco Free Workplace:

- a) Any Contractor performing work for the Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation agrees to publish a statement notifying all employees, subcontractors, and other workers that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in the Contractor's workplace and specifying the actions that will be taken against violators of such prohibition.
- b) The Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation will consider lack of enforcement or lax enforcement of the statement by the Contractor a default of the contract.
- c) The Contractor further agrees to provide all persons engaged in performance of the contract with a copy of the statement.
- d) A copy of the Contractor's Drug Free Workplace statement shall be included with any bid submitted or the Contractor will be deemed to accept and agree to use the statement provided by the Nation.
- e) The Contractor understands and recognizes that all Housing Authority of the Cherokee Nation buildings, whether leased or owned, and the grounds surrounding those facilities are considered by the Nation to be a tobacco free workplace. The Contractor will ensure all employees, subcontractors, and other workers will abide by this policy.

Box 1007 Tahlequah, Oklahoma 74465 as additional insured/certificate holder. – Sub Contractor’s insurance certificates must list the General Contractor as the additional insured/certificate holder.

CORE CREW LIST – Copies of CDIB or Tribal Membership cards for all core crew members (General and Sub Contractors)

LICENSES– specific for the job, Example – HVAC, Plumbing, Electrical, Termite Treatment, Roofing.

Drywall Hanging Labor and Materials

SCOPE OF WORK Contractor must provide material, tools, equipment, and labor to install the following:

Hang all drywall. ½” thick ceiling board. Screws shall be driven with their shanks perpendicular to face of board 7” to 8” o.c. on ceilings and 1 ¼” GWB Annular ring flat head ¼” diameter on sidewalls. All Sheet rock must be screwed installed and not nailed, no more than four (4) nails per sheet. ALL wet areas, will be green rock from the ceiling to the floor. Wet areas include the Utility area, Bathroom and the Kitchen.

Bid shall include all material, tools, equipment, and labor to perform all work:

3-BEDROOM UNIT BID: \$ _____

Drywall Finishing Labor and Materials

SCOPE OF WORK

Mud, Tape, and Finish all drywall. ½” thick ceiling board shall have tapered or beveled edges. All joints and corners shall be taped. Edges will be sanded and feathered after each coat. Inside corners shall be reinforced with tape. Outside corners shall be protected by metal molding or metal corner reinforcement. All tape and metal accessories shall be imbedded in thin layer of joint cement. Cement three (3) coats over all nails and tape. All mudded and taped areas will be sanded and feathered after each coat. Drywall finish is to be orange peel texture

Bid shall include all materials (listed above), tools, equipment, and labor to perform all work. Contractor has verified all material cost and reviewed the enclosed plan. The individual bid amounts include all labor and materials. .HACN will build 6 homes with Gable Roofs and 5 homes with HIP Style Roofs.

Contractor will be responsible for their own clean up, HACN will supply the dumpster.
