Cherokee National Holiday Quilt Show LIVE

Cherokee Casino Tahlequah | Room 2&3

30August2024 | 1:00 p.m.

- What time can production load into the room to setup? In other words, how much time is allowed for setup? The Quilt Show is going through set up as early as Tuesday August 27th. I recommend setting up on August 28th & 29th if needed.
- 2. When does production need to be out of the room? I wouldn't say there's a tight deadline for being out of the room, it is reserved through Tuesday, September 3rd.
- 3. Approximately, at what time does the quilt show LIVE feed end? Last year the Quilt Show Live Feed lasted approximately 1.5 hours last year.
- 4. How large is the anticipated in-person audience for rooms 2 and 3? I am going to guess around 50 total maybe 75 total including staff.
- 5. Is the casino providing internet for streaming or does this bid need to include an outside line?

 No, wifi is provided by the Casino team.
- 6. If the casino is providing the internet, is it hard-wired or wireless? **Hardwire**.

- What time can production load into the room to setup? In other words, how much time is allowed for setup? Initial set up for all events at the Chota can begin on August 28th & run through August 29th.
- 2. What time does production need to be out of the room? September 3rd close of business.
- 3. Can any equipment be left in this room for the next day's Fiddler event? Yes. That should be good to go.
- **4.** Approximately, at what time does the musical consortium LIVE feed end? **Our live feed ran for 1.15 hours last year.**
- 5. How large is the anticipated in-person audience for rooms 1 and 6? 300
- 6. How many people are in the choir? **Approximately 25-30.**

- 5. How large is the anticipated in-person audience? 20,000 at the busiest point in time.
- 6. Do speakers/sound system need to be provided for the in-person audience? If so, how many people and how large is the coverage area? Approximately 200,000 square feet with 20,000 people.
- 7. Does the sound system need to be flown or ground supported? On scaffolding risers.
- 8. Do microphones need to be supplied to the announcer's booth? If "yes," how many and what styles? (Wired? Wireless? Lavaliere? Countrymen?) 5 wireless.
- 9. Where are other microphones needed? 1 runner microphone.
- 10. Does lighting need to be provided to light the announcer's booth for video? No.
- 11. Is a spotlight with operator required for dancers on the PowWow grounds? No.
- 12. Is hard-wired internet provided or does the bid need to including bringing in an outside line? We are working on getting the Cultural Grounds Hard-Wired.
- 13. What size LED screen is requested or required for this event? 72 LED Video Panels total.
- 14. If mobile LED screens on the back of a trailer are required, how many total units are requested?
- 15. Will staging be provided for the production crew? No.
- **16.** Will a tent be provided for the production crew? **No, we recommend an RV is provided by the** crew.

- 20. Will there be reserved parking for (1) 56' semi-trailer and (2) 24' box trucks? We only have room for vehicles that will be in use for the event. Otherwise, we will need those to drop off equipment and be parked somewhere else.
