QUESTIONS/ANSWERS:

1. With the existing fiber needing to be rerouted, the plans show the new fiber to be located in the new addition's janitor closet. This will cause the whole building to be without fiber until the new addition is built. Is that the plan for this project? Or does the fiber need to be rerouted back to the existing IT/router so the building can have internet access?

ANSWER: See VE Narrative where it states that the IT closet has been removed from the expansion. Data drops will be pulled from the existing location. Refer to the drawings for technology item locations and adjust accordingly to the changes that occurred during the VE practice.

2. Who's scope of work includes the sawcutting of the existing concrete to get the new service entrance to the building? Who's responsible for patching the concrete after the service entrance is installed?

ANSWER: Scope of who is doing the work is the responsibility of the general contractor.

3. Who's responsible for the trenching for the new service entrance pipe and wire?

ANSWER: Scope of who is doing the work is the responsibility of the general contractor.

4. The plans say the electrical contractor is responsible for the new transformer pad, where is the new pad going to be located?

ANSWER: According to ES1.0 there is not a new transformer or pad. On E1.1 it mentions a new pad if replacement of the transformer is required but that would be coordinated at that time.

5. Who is the electrical provider?

ANSWER: See C1.00 where it states the Tahlequah Public Works Authority provides the electric.

6. Who is the fiber provider?

ANSWER: This is a Cherokee Nation Owned Fiber line, but a fiber contractor hired by the General Contractor will be required to move it. The fiber contractor must coordinate its relocation with Cherokee Nation IT department.
