QUESTIONS/ANSWERS:

Area #5 has asphalt surface; there is several spots that are low and cracking. Do you want to repair those areas, or just overlay them?
 If we overlay what is there, they will continue to hold water, and the cracking will reflect in surface before the 1-year warranty is up.

ANSWER: All preparation of existing asphalt surface, including patching, shall be included in the price bid for Area #5.

2. What do you want to do with extra rock removed from the sites? Is there a place you want it?

ANSWER: Selected Contractor will coordinate with School Superintendent Leann Barnwell (918-964-1986) for a proposed site to place extra rock, if needed.

3. Is this project Tax-Exempt?

ANSWER: CONTRACTORS ARE TO CALCULATE ANTICIPATED TAXES AND INCLUDE THE COST WITH THEIR BID SUBMITTAL.

4. Will there be any testing done on the subgrade or asphalt?

ANSWER: No testing will be required.

5. We have done several jobs for the Cherokee Nation and most of the time they don't like the segregated areas that will show up in the S4 mix, any chance they would change the mix to S5?

ANSWER: Cherokee Nation will entertain a bid for either S4 or S5 mixes.

6. Will there be a striping Plan?

ANSWER: The contractor will be responsible for layout of striping in the parking lot. Striping will consist of 10'x20' stalls and 24' driving lanes. Handicapped parking symbols will be utilized in areas that have existing Handicapped signs.

JAY PUBLIC SCHOOL PARKING LOTS Grade, Drain, and Surfacing

The following are changes and additions to the Plans, Specification and Standards Drawings for this project.

1. Question – What type of Asphalt will be used?

Answer: Type S4 (64-220K) – No recycled asphalt

2. Who will layout the striping in the parking lots? Will handicapped signs be needed?

Answer: The contractor will be responsible for layout of striping in the parking lot. Striping will consist of 10'x20' stalls and 24' driving lanes. Handicapped parking symbols will be used in areas that have existing Handicapped signs.

- What type of paint will be required?
 Answer: Correction of answer of Multi-Polymer given at the meeting. CNDOT will accept Traffic Stripe (4")(Paint).
- 4. Alternative 1 has been added to the bid as follows:
 - Add a separate bid for Parking Stops in the North Football Field along the fence line next to the stadium to protect cars from running into fence. Contractor will determine how many parking stops are needed once striping is laid out.
