Questions:

- Is there a preferred video surveillance platform and/or camera manufacturer that Cherokee Nation would like utilized for the trailer buildout?

Response: We prefer a system comparable to Uniview Dual PTZ/ fixed cameras.

- Are there preferred lighting configurations for the trailer, specifically regarding:
 - Top and bottom status/indicator lights
 - Spot lights and flood lights mounted on the upper mast or trailer body

Response: Top and bottom are both preferred. Spot/Flood lights mounted on the upper mast.

- Is there a preferred control or management platform for remote monitoring and operation of trailer functions, including:
 - Remote generator monitoring and management
 - Remote generator start/stop and power cycling
 - Power generation and consumption monitoring
 - Remote health/status monitoring of onboard systems and devices

Response: We have no preferred control or management platform; however, it is imperative that all items above are included as part of a remote management platform.

- Are there any existing standards, interoperability requirements, or preferred manufacturers for the trailer control and telemetry systems?

Response: The preferred requirements are included in the bid announcement.

- Are you able to provide more information on the type of SIM card that you will be providing.
 - Is it static/fixed IP to ensure the device keeps the same IP?

Response: Each camera needs to have a SIM card installed. Cameras will be required to have static IP addresses.

- Can we request that a static IP SIM be provided to ensure proper functionality?

Response: The cameras will need to have a static IP.

- Can that SIM also have route capability?

Response: Not familiar with SIM cards having route capabilities. More information would be required to accurately respond to this question.

- **Governing Evaluation Method:** Will award be made to the responsive bidder with the lowest price or will the Nation conduct a best-value assessment considering all six evaluation criteria?

Response: Every bid received will be evaluated and compared with the bid specifications.

Factor Weights: If it is a best-value assessment where the Nation will assess factors and compare against other bidders, rather than treat them as pass/fail... ○ What is the relative weight or order of importance of those factors— particularly price versus non-price factors combined?

Response: Every bid received will be evaluated and compared with the bid specifications.

- Will bidders be evaluated more favorably for exceeding specifications? *Response: No*

- Will bidders be evaluated more favorably by proposing other features not set forth in the specifications? *Response: No*

- **Maximum budget price:** Will the established maximum be disclosed, and will bids exceeding it be rejected?

Response: No

- **Buy American applicability:** The RFB's Buy American Recovery Act clause refers to "construction, alteration, maintenance or repair of a public building or public work." This is a procurement of a manufactured trailer (mobile equipment), not a public works construction project. Does Buy American apply here, and if so, to which components?
