applicants/employees outside the 14 counties in Northeastern Oklahoma comprising the Cherokee Nation and where in the 50

states they've taken place?

Answer #7: The number of tests conducted for applicants/employees outside

the Cherokee Nation 14-county area will vary; however, historically, there have been less than 10 conducted on an annual basis. The location will vary depending on location of applicant's residence

and employees who may be on business travel.
