The following questions and/or requests for clarification were submitted in accordance with the Request for Proposal for Transcription Services.

Question: Page 1-General Information, Item 2- Are there any unique professional license

or registration requirements for this RFP?

Response: No.

Question: Page 1-General Information, Item 3- Is TERO certification required for

submitting this proposal, or just if awarded?

Response: The Cherokee Nation will accept proposals from Indian owned and non-Indian

owned companies. The Indian Preference will be provided only to those

responding parties that are TERO Certified and submit proof with their proposal.

Question: Page 5-Terms and Conditions-General Responsibility- Reference is made to

Coding and Billing consulting. Will Coding and Billing services be part of this

RFP?

Response: Disregard the reference. This Request for Proposal is for Transcription Services

only.

Question: Page 11-Proposal Requirements- Experience working with IHS/Tribal

Facilities- Does an absence of this preclude competing for this project?

Response: No.

Question: Page 11-Specifications/Scope of Work- Are the STAT jobs 2-hour turnaround

for normal business hours, or 24x7? Is there an approximate number of STAT jobs to plan for? Do the multiple sites share a Cerner EHR or is each facility a

standalone platform?

Response: Normal business hours for stat turnaround, based on central time zone. There are

very few stat dictations. All Cherokee Nation sites share in the Cerner EHR, only 2 sites utilize the dictation services, Cherokee Nation W. W. Hastings Hospital and Cherokee Nation Outpatient Health Center, both based in Tahlequah.

Question: What is the approximate number of dictating users?

Response: 15

Question: Is there a projected volume of work (lines, pages, etc.)? **Response:** The total for the contract should give an idea of volume.

Question: Is there a list (and approximate volume) of document types to be transcribed?

Response: There are 7 document types

Question: How will the completed work need to be returned to the Cerner EHR? Interface

required?

Response: A link will between the company and Cerner EHR will have to be completed.

This has previously been the responsibility of the transcription service.

Question: Is there a local presence required in Oklahoma for you to consider our company

as a viable candidate since we are located in Kentucky? We have been

performing transcription for 20 years and have the latest technology in order for

us to provide this service remotely.

Response: Transcription has been performed remotely, out of state, for almost 13 years.

Question: Where can I find the rating criteria with Nations Health Services? This is

referenced in the RFP but I do not see contents or a link to find out the

information.

Response: The rating criteria is listed on page 10 of the Request for Proposal

Question: Regarding the insurance, is proof required to be submitted with the proposal or

only if we are awarded the contract?

Response: Only if awarded.

Question: Also regarding the insurance, there was listed information about auto insurance. If

this is done remotely is that something that needs to be provided.

Response: The final insurance requirement and review will be completed by the Risk

Management Department and shared with the awarded party regarding the auto

insurance.

Question: For the pricing, does it require to be separated from the technical response

and any particular format requirement (per line)?

Response: Per line is preferred

Question: What is the current volume & the pricing the incumbent is charging?

Response: This information will not be shared.

Question: Under the Scope of Work, Proposal Requirements section, it states experience

working with IHS/Tribal Facilities is a requirement. Will proposals from new

vendors without experience be accepted?

Response: Yes.

Question: If this is not a new requirement, please let us know what is currently being paid

for the service.

Response: This information will not be shared.

Question: Is the solicitation open to contractors that <u>do not</u> have a TERO certification?

Response: The Cherokee Nation will accept proposals from Indian owned and non-Indian

owned companies. The Indian Preference will be provided only to those

responding parties that are TERO Certified and submit proof with their proposal.

Question: I noticed in the evaluation factors item 6. states Indian Preference - **TERO**

Certification must accompany response.

Response: The Indian Preference will be provided only to those responding parties that are

TERO Certified and submit proof with their proposal.

Question: Who is the incumbent vendor, and what is the current cost of transcription for this

contract?

Response: This information will not be shared.

Ouestion: What is the current monthly volume of transcription?

Response: Very low at this point with pandemic and not performing elective surgeries.

Reference responses to other questions.

Question: How many dictators utilize the current transcription service?

Response: Can be up to 15

Question: In which format would you prefer the pricing to be broke down into; VBC, Line,

or other?

Response: Line

Question: Can you please give an estimate or a previous year's average?

Response: Between 30,000-50,000 lines per month

Question: What are the average work types that are dictated most often?

Response: Op notes, EEG notes, clinic progress notes are the 3 most used job types

Question: Who is the NATION's current transcription provider?

Response: This information will not be shared.

Question: Are you seeking specific technology (i.e., Front-end Speech Recognition, Back-end

Speech Recognition)?

Response: We are only seeking transcription services not speech recongition

Question: Do your providers currently utilize Speech Recognition technology?

Response: This is only for transcription services not speech recognition

Question: What are volumes of transcription (monthly, or quarterly, or annually)?

Response: During the pandemic this is unable to be calculated accurately. Reference

responses to other questions.

Question: Do you prefer billing by the line? Or, by the VBC?

Response: By line

Question: Other than TERO Certification, do vendors have to register with Indian Health

Services or Cherokee Nation to submit proposals?

Response: No.

Question: Do Oklahoma-based vendors get any special consideration - (i.e., If all things are

equal between two vendors, and one is from Oklahoma and the other vendor is from

another state, how will the NATION decide?)

Response: Location is not a preference. The only preference is Indian-owned as outlined in

the RFP.

Question: Is the goal for the NATION to award the contract to only one bidder?

Response: Yes

Question: Will NATION be scheduling a platform demo as part of the final decision-making

process?

Response: At the discretion of Cherokee Nation, selected offerors may be invited to supply

additional information on the contents of their proposal. Such offerors could be asked to give a presentation and demonstrations of their proposal (possibly with an

emphasis on a topic or topics of Cherokee Nation's choice) followed by a question and answer session. Presentations will be done remotely. NOTE: Presentations, demonstrations or other individual contact is expressly prohibited during the proposal process; refer to RFP.
