QUESTION: Is the organizational structure review intended to focus on all government functions (government functions listed on your website) or a subset of government functions? If a subset, then which functions?

QUESTION: Our firm has extensive experience in organizational structure and HR projects, including work with Tribal entities. However, while we have "knowledge" of "indirect cost pools," we don't really work in that area. Does the RFPQ require, and is the Tribe looking to certify firms that have, experience in *all three* areas, or may a firm qualify for work in only one or two of the areas in which it has expertise?

RESPONSE: The preference is to certify firms that have working knowledge and experience in all three areas.

QUESTION: I would like to mail hard copies and digital copy to you. Is this acceptable? If so, how many hard copies would be required? Likewise, what physical address should be used?
