To assess an Employee Rights Fee of one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%) on all covered contracts. This fee is being waived for this project.

11.1.3 - The Work Permits paragraph of the Tribal Emplyment Rights Office (TERO) Project Labor Agreement - Master Agreement LA 01-14 states: No person who is not a member of a federally recognizzed tribe shall be employed by a covered employer until he or she has optained a work permit from the TERO at a cost of twenty-five dollars (\$25) per day, per permit. Subcontractors are to EXCLUDE in their proposed price for the work, all costs associated with the twenty-five (\$25) per day work permit for every non-Indian idividual employed on this project.

This fee is being waived for this project.

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8. Sales Tax

All bids must be submitted exclusive of Federal Excise Tax and Oklahoma State Sales Tax. The Cherokee Nation is exempt from Oklahoma State Sales Tax and Federal Excise Tax under authority of § Okla. Stat. Supp. 1994 Section 1356. Bidder is to include and pay all other applicable sales tax and use taxes as required. Applications for payment shall be broken down as required by the Owner or Construction Manager.

9. Davis-Bacon Wage Scale

Awarded parties will be required to maintain wage rates paid to employees for any future awarded project and have reports available upon request. And, 40 U.S.C.A. §3702 & §3704 per Department of Labor regulations regarding work hours and conditions. Cherokee Nation TERO law and fees are is applicable to any future agreement
