QUESTIONS & ANSWERS FOR CNH  
EVENT MESH BANNERS

1. Can we bid for this job even if we aren't TERO certified? **Bids will be accepted from Indian and Non-Indian bidders Cherokee Nation reserves the right to reject any and all bids.**
2. Does 30% Ad means 30% airflow allowed? **Yes.**
3. Will these be all single sided mesh? **We are only printing on one side the other side will be attached to scaffolding.**
4. Could you please share the bid tabulation from previous purchase? **If this was bid out previously it can be researched on our bid website showing who was awarded.**

**Qty 2: 50'x30' front and back at 30% Ad Mesh Single Sided, Size: 360" x 600", Fabrication: Webbing 2" Rolled Webbing All, #2 Grommets Every 2' All Sides. End caps for the scaffolding should be 30% Ad Mesh Single Sided, Size: 360" x 120", Fabrication: Webbing 2" Rolled Webbing All, #2 Grommets Every 2' all sides.**

**Qty 2: End Caps 10'x30' at 30% Ad Mesh Single Sided, Size: 360" x 120", Fabrication: Webbing 2" Rolled Webbing All, #2 Grommets Every 2' All Sides.**

5. In line item 1: Here, banner size is mentioned, do we have standard pole for the end caps, as we want to know the end cap size needed? (as pole is not required in the bid) **We will have a scaffolding frame to install all the mesh banners to.**
  
6. Line item 2 is banner with 10'x 30' size, along with end caps? **Please see image example from last year. The 10'x30' is the end on the 50x30 flag structure.**



7. Is TERO registration is compulsory to take part in the bid? **Bid Acceptance: Bids will be accepted from Indian and Non-Indian bidders Cherokee Nation reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Cherokee Nation reserves the right to determine if a bid meets stated requirements, and to award a purchase order for the bid that is in the best interest of the Cherokee Nation including but not limited to the total cost and capability of the bidder. Bidders are responsible for any and all costs associated**

**with the preparation and submission of bids. To be considered, bids must be received by the specified date and time; any bid received after stipulated date and time will be returned unopened. No bidder may withdraw their bid within 30 days after proposal due date.**
